ROAD TO PRAIA D'EL REY

COMPETITION

WHAT IS IT

This is a final tournament on the 23th of July where the best 30 players and ties of the season will compete to win the Copa D'El Rey.

This very well sponsored tournament, by main sponsor Rey Estates (Thanks Tom) and with the support of Francisco will have the equivalent of a prize fund in excess of €2000!!!

HOW DOES IT WORK

A point system for the Roll up will be effective as of Wednesday 18th of August till the 20Th of July next year. 4 Major roll ups will be introduced to gain double points.



HOW DOES THE POINT SYSTEM WORK

- On every Wednesday the amount of players equals the amount of points available. For example 40 Players equals 40 points.
- The points will be allocated to the top 10 ranking of that Wednesday.
- The point allocation is based on a fixed percentage by ranking. The higher the ranking, the higher the percentage.

Example: 40 players, ranked #1, 100% means 40 points. Ranked #2, 80% means 32 points.

- Major roll ups will have double points. 40 Players means 80 points. No change in % allocation.
- -All points will be added till the 20Th of July.
- -Format is stableford

HOW TO QUALIFY

3 ways to qualify:

Obviously the more Wednesday's you play the bigger the opportunity to qualify. However to facilitate the less frequent players (because of travel restrictions) and to also support the weekend players there are more ways to qualify like in the Ryder cup!

1.The winner of a major will qualify directly!
2.The top 5 of the OM's in PDR and WC also qualify directly.
3.The remaining spots will be filled up till 30 and ties from the ranking of the roll up.

On the 23th of July all qualified players have an equal chance to win of the Copa Del Rey!
