Competition Qualification

As we have advised in the past all players need to have submitted three cards within a six month rolling period to be eligible for prizes in our club competitions. The rationale behind this is to make sure that we are complying with the requirements as laid down by World Golf. As a committee we will monitor all entrants and if you do not have the required number of cards you will be advised that you cannot win a prize. Please also remember this applies to pairs, order of merit, club championships etc.

However I would like to share some statistics with you from the last couple of years:

These are the figures from the 1st of Jan 2022 to 31st of May.

More than 3 cards - 35%

1 or 2 cards - 24%

o cards - 41%

The corresponding figure for period from 1st January 2022 to 13th February 2023 are -

More than 3 cards - 62%

1 or 2 cards - 14%

o cards - 24%

As can be seen we have improved the number of official scores over this period which is great. Please remember a social round is an official score and should in fact be submitted, this can be either 9 or 18 holes.
